MASTER'S THESIS

Thesis Title: Effects of Socialization and Demographical Factors on Arts Participation: A Focus on the Classical Music Attendance of American College Students

Abstract: Research from my paper covers American college students' interest in the performing arts. I analyze how one's socialization, age, education, and socio-economic status determine whether that student will become a dedicated arts participant in the future. One's "Socialization" and "Age" were examined within The Survey for Participation in the Arts (SPPA) of 1982 and 1992 studies supplied by The National Endowment for the Arts. One's "Education" and "socio-economic status" were examined within the SPPA 2002. The highlighted factors frequently served as a focal point for researchers who have conducted previous similar studies. The participant refers to a student who is not studying to be a professional artist or performer but is an avid arts consumer who regularly attends live classical music concerts or listens to classical music through media.
